ACS is a Year 1-13 school with a growing roll and opportunities for teachers to work to their strengths. The student population is culturally diverse. Any knowledge in Maori, Pacifica or other cultures would be beneficial, but is not essential.

Our motto, and overall purpose, is to glorify God which is achieved through teachers who believe in and depend on Jesus as their lord and saviour. Our vision keeps our purpose in focus. The successful applicant will be part of a team building that vision in the secondary years.

ACS began in 2009 with 27 Year 1-8 students, was integrated into the state system in 2011 before extending to Year 10 in 2015. We have been growing steadily in numbers and will begin 2022 with over 200 pupils and a roll cap of 345 pupils. There will be two year 7-8 classes in 2022, with just over 20 students in each.

We have strong links to other schools and a strong multi-school proprietor, The Christian Schools Trust. This ensures access to other more established schools and their expertise. We also have strong links to the local community and are part of the Hakatere Kahui Ako.

Our school is strongly family focussed and so supports teachers to keep a healthy personal and work life balance.
